Manager's Message

Lakewood Village RV sites are ready for occupancy!! We have our very first occupant as of August 26th.

The compound project is moving ahead. The committee will be assigning spots for RV's. trailers, commercial equipment etc., in September. The spots are being numbered and each row will have specific information for what will go in them. There will be a charge for anyone desiring more than one spot. Everyone that has their property in the compound will need to come in to the office and reregister your property so the committee can start out with current information. PROCESS FOR SELLING YOUR HOME

- 1. An Intent to Sell must be filled out.
- The ARC committee will do a review of the property and notify the homeowner of anything that needs to be done before selling the property.
- 3. Any perspective buyer must come to the office and fill out the application for residency. There is a \$50.00 fee per adult. Part of the application is the credit history and criminal background check, which is done by the office, prior to purchasing the home. The prospective new residents must be approved by the interview committee and the BOD.
- 4. The title to the mobile home should be transferred immediately to the new owner once approved and the closing is complete.
- 5. If a share is involved in the purchase the Atlantic Coastal does the closing.

Please be advised that we **ARE** taking a stronger stance on the inspections; from this point forward if you do not comply with the letter received or contact the office your file **WILL BE** sent to the attorney for eviction or foreclosure for non-compliance. If the home needs to be weeded or pressure washed and this is not completed then it will be done by the Association and the fees will be passed on to the resident. If the fees aren't paid, the amount will be sent to attorney for non-payment.

We all wish to live in a beautiful maintained Community that you can be proud to call home. The Board of Directors is also looking at eventually bringing new homes into the Community to try and fill the many vacant lots we have, but when houses are left a mess and not maintained; it makes that task much harder to achieve. 
