HOME INSPECTIONS

Unfortunately, we also have some residents who choose not to comply with the rules and regulations when it comes to maintaining their home. Please be advised that we ARE taking a stronger stance on the inspections; from this point forward if you do not comply with the letter received or contact the office your file WILL BE sent to the attorney for eviction or foreclosure for non-compliance. If the home needs to be weeded or pressure washed and this is not completed then it will be done by the Association and the fees will be passed on to the resident. If the fees aren't paid, the amount will be sent to attorney for non-payment.

We all wish to live in a beautiful maintained Community that you can be proud to call home. Summit Communities is planning on bringing new homes into the Community to try and fill the many vacant lots we have, but when houses are left a mess and not maintained; it makes that task much harder to achieve. People want to live in a Community where residents take pride in the way their home looks. The better your home looks the easier it is for our future residents to say "Yes! SELLING YOUR HOME

1. AN INTENT TO SELL MUST BE FILLED OUT.

- 2. The ARC committee will do a review of the property and notify the homeowner of anything that needs to be done before selling the property.
- 3. Any perspective buyer must come to the office and fill out the application for residency. There is a \$50.00 fee per adult. Part of the application is the credit history and criminal background check, which is done by the office, prior to purchasing the home. The prospective new residents must be approved by the Lakewood Village Manager.
- 4. The title to the mobile home should be transferred immediately to the new owner once approved and the closing is complete.



FOUR LEGGED PETS

ALL FOUR -LEGGED PETS OVER THE AGE OF 4 MONTHS MUST BE LICENSED. IT IS UNLAWFUL TO ALLOW PETS TO RUN AT LARGE (OFF THE PROPERTY OF THE OWNER) THIS INCLUDES ALL DOGS AND CATS, KEEPING A HABITUALLY LOUD BARKING, YELPING OR HOWLING DOMESTIC PET IS UNLAWFUL. THE FLORIDA STATUTE ALOWS THE PARK TO FINE UP TO \$100.00 PER VIOLATION

- Please do not feed the feral cats or other wildlife around the neighborhood.
- ➤ We would like to remind everyone to look at their home and home site to ensure that it looks the best it could possibly look. We would like everyone to be proud of where they live and have their family and friends envy our Community.
- We love our 4-legged residents, but ask that when you are walking them around the community or in the dog park to please pick up after them so that other residents and their pets may enjoy the same right. Also, please do your best to avoid your dog from using a resident's yard. Although you may pick up after the dog there is usually something left behind


